The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Weston Farnes** has unlawfully acted as an adjuster in the State of Arizona. Accordingly, the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona (the "Director") makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-292 as applied to adjusters under A.R.S. § 20-321.02.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Weston Farnes ("Respondent" or "Farnes") is not licensed with the
 Department as an adjuster. Farnes is not exempt from the licensing requirement.
- Farnes' address is: c/o True-Built Construction, LLC, 6317 S. Banning Street,
 Gilbert, Arizona 85298.
- 3. On February 22, 2010, Farnes faxed an "Authorization" to Cory Rice at Liberty Mutual regarding Claim # 016918023-01. The Authorization stated that Farnes was representing Arlene Stahm "for the sole purpose of negotiating with Liberty on my behalf to obtain full reimbursement under the terms of my policy for a property damage claim."

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. An adjuster means any person who for compensation, fee or commission either adjusts, investigates or negotiates settlement of claims arising under insurance

contracts on behalf of an insured or holds oneself out to perform those services, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-321(A).

- 3. Respondent is not exempt from the licensing requirement, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-321(B).
- 4. Respondent's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes acting as or claiming to be an adjuster without being licensed as an adjuster, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-321.01(A).
- 5. Grounds exist to issue a cease and desist order to Respondent for acting as or claiming to be an adjuster without being licensed, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-292 as applied to adjusters under A.R.S. § 20-321.02.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from unlawfully acting as or claiming to be an adjuster.
- 2. This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

Pursuant to Title 20 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, Respondents are hereby notified that they may request a hearing pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-161 to contest the order to cease and desist. Such a request must be in writing and received at the following address within thirty (30) days from the date hereof:
