CONSENT ORDER

Respondent

The Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions (“Department”) has received evidence that **Alyssa Kathleen Mccoyrehling (“Respondent”)** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S”). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona non-resident insurance producer with two (2) lines of authority: life, and accident or health and sickness. The Department issued Respondent’s license, number 17283860, on August 15, 2017. The license is scheduled to expire on April 30, 2021.

2. Respondent’s business and mailing address of record with the Department is 8154 Manitoba Street #4, Playa Del Rey, California 90293. Respondent’s business e-mail address of record with the Department is alysa_rehling@us.aflac.com.

1 **Insurer Complaint**

2 3. On or about October 13, 2020, American Family Life Assurance Company of
3 Columbus (“Aflac”) notified the Department of the termination of Respondent’s appointment
4 with the company effective September 29, 2020. Aflac alleged that Respondent created
5 bogus businesses for persons who did not exist and established bogus groups to get payroll
6 rates.

7 4. Upon receipt of Aflac’s records the Department determined that the allegations
8 involved California policyholders (bogus persons and groups); therefore, the Department has
9 no jurisdiction in this matter.

10 5. During the investigation of Aflac’s complaint, the Department discovered that
11 Respondent’s resident producer license in California expired on June 30, 2020, for failure to
12 renew her license.

13 6. Respondent failed to maintain an active and in good standing resident license
14 in her home state.

15 7. Respondent’s business email address of record is no longer valid given her
16 termination from Aflac on September 29, 2020. Respondent has failed to provide a current
17 email address to the Department.

18 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

19 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

20 2. Respondent’s conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20 or
21 any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

1 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a failure to maintain her
2 license in good standing in her home state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-287(A)(1) .

3 4. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to inform the
4 Director in writing within thirty days of any change in the licensee's residential, business, or
5 email address, a violation of A.R.S. § 20-286(C)(1).

6 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or
7 revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

8 **ORDER**

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

10 The insurance producer license of **Alyssa Kathleen Mccoysrehling**, National
11 Producer Number 17283860, is revoked, effective immediately.

5 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
6 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce her to enter into this Consent
7 Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

8 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
9 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
10 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
11 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

12 7. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
13 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
14 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledge that she must report this administrative action to
15 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
16 administrative action on any license application.
