Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance and Financial Institutions by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Nationwide Mutual Fire Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is an Ohio domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective January 5, 1956.
- 2. Effective January 1, 2023, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company (NMIC), NAIC No. 23787, an Ohio domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. NMIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Ohio approved the merger of Petitioner into NMIC on October 27, 2022.
- 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
