THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN HEARD on the 30th day of April, 1982, and all oral and written comments submitted prior to and at the hearing having been considered as well as other matters of which the Director may take notice, the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona finds that the list of recognized surplus lines adopted by Order of the Director on October 6, 1981, should be amended.
